SCHEDULE:

Day 1 - Arrival & Introduction

- 1:00 pm - 4:00 pm Arrive at departure location, organize car pooling, and depart for Rancho El Aribabi.
- 4:00 pm - 5:00 pm Upon arrival, casually unload into your accommodations, and then meet other participants and workshop instructor.
- 5:00 pm - 6:00 pm Start of workshop with an introductory presentation. Please see the workshop description for additional details.
- 6:00 pm and after Dinner with the remainder of the evening open.

Day 2 - Workshop Tour & Presentations

- 6:00 am - 7:00 am Breakfast at your leisure.
- 7:00 am - 4:00 pm Workshop tour of the different habitats in and around Rancho El Aribabi. The tour will be broken up throughout the day with three powerpoint presentations, lunch, and other breaks.
- 4:00 pm - 6:00 pm Return to the ranch lodgings no later than 4:00 pm. Conclusion of days activities and free time to enjoy the surroundings.
- 6:00 pm and after Dinner with the remainder of the evening open.

Day 3 - Workshop Tour & Departure

- 6:00 am - 7:00 am Breakfast at your leisure.
- 7:00 am - 11:00 am Workshop tour of the different habitats in and around Rancho El Aribabi.
- 11:00 am Checkout with an hour to pack and load, followed by departure from the ranch by noon.

LODGING: The package includes two nights at Rancho El Aribabi in Sonora, Mexico, in the foothills of the Sierra Madres. Lodging is based on double occupancy, single occupancy is unavailable for these workshops.

MEALS: The package includes: two (2) full breakfasts, three (3) lunches, and two (2) dinners.

TRANSPORTATION: Participants are responsible for their own transportation to and from Rancho El Aribabi. Carpooling is highly encouraged. Auto insurance for Mexico is **REQUIRED** to drive into Mexico. The tour will depart from and return to the Sky Island Alliance offices at 300 East University Boulevard in Tucson, Arizona.

LOGISTICS: This workshop is held in Sonora, Mexico. A passport or other approved form of identification is **REQUIRED** for entrance to Mexico and return to the U.S. The workshop is limited to 12 participants with a minimum of 6 participants required.

RESERVATIONS & CANCELLATIONS: Cost of the workshop is \$275 per person. A deposit of \$125 per person is required within 7 days of reserving a space. The remainder of the fee is due upon arrival at the point of departure. We happily accept checks or cash only. Checks should be made payable to Aplomado Environmental LLC. Full refunds or credit toward a future workshop will be given for cancellations more than 60 days before the workshop. Cancellations less than 60 days before the workshop will forfeit the deposit unless filled by another participant, less a \$25 processing fee.

DISCOUNTS: A 10% discount is available if you make reservations for 2 or more persons, or for groups of 10 to 12 people. Please inquire for more details.
